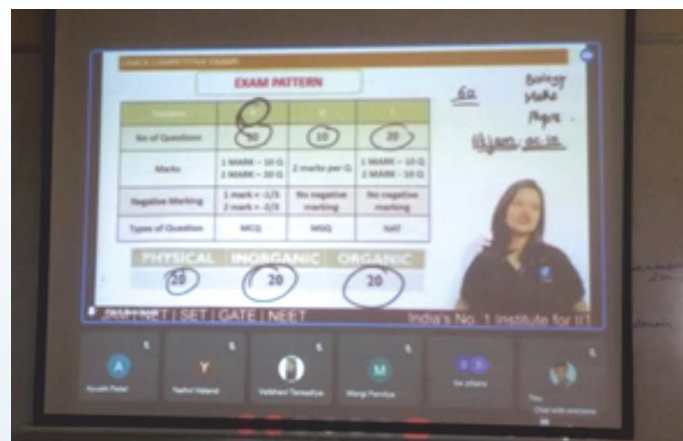


## KRISHNA SCHOOL OF SCIENCE (KSS)

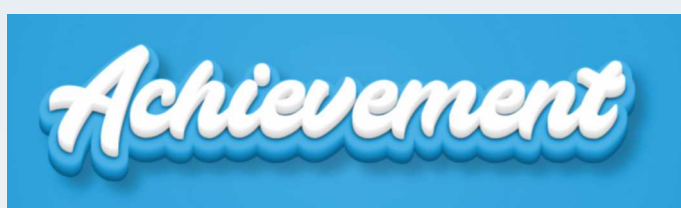




● **SSIP Sensitization Event** for Krishna School of Science (KSS) on 14<sup>th</sup> December 2022

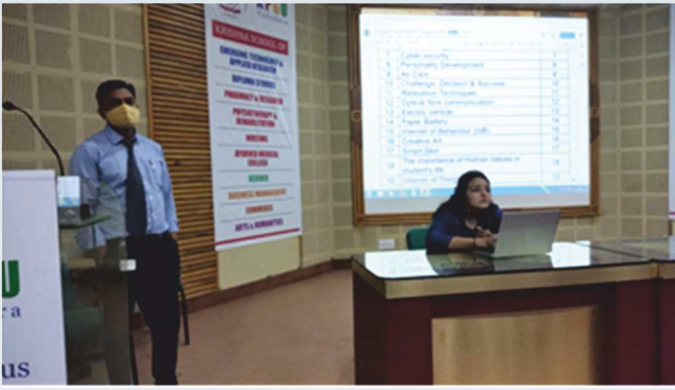

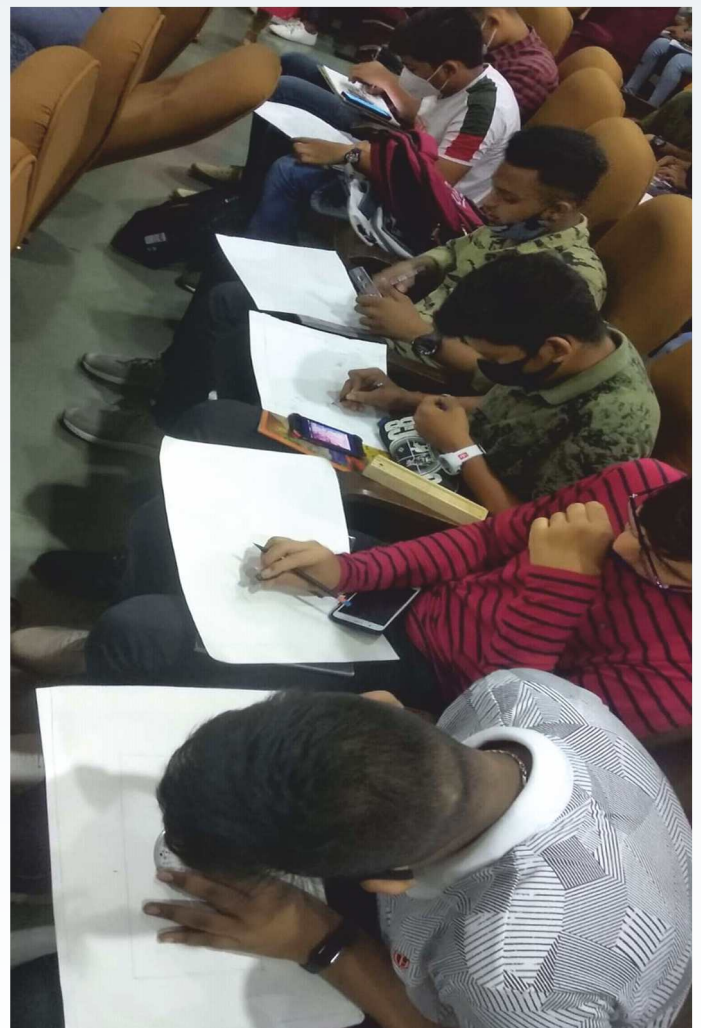

● **COOKERY PROGRAM**

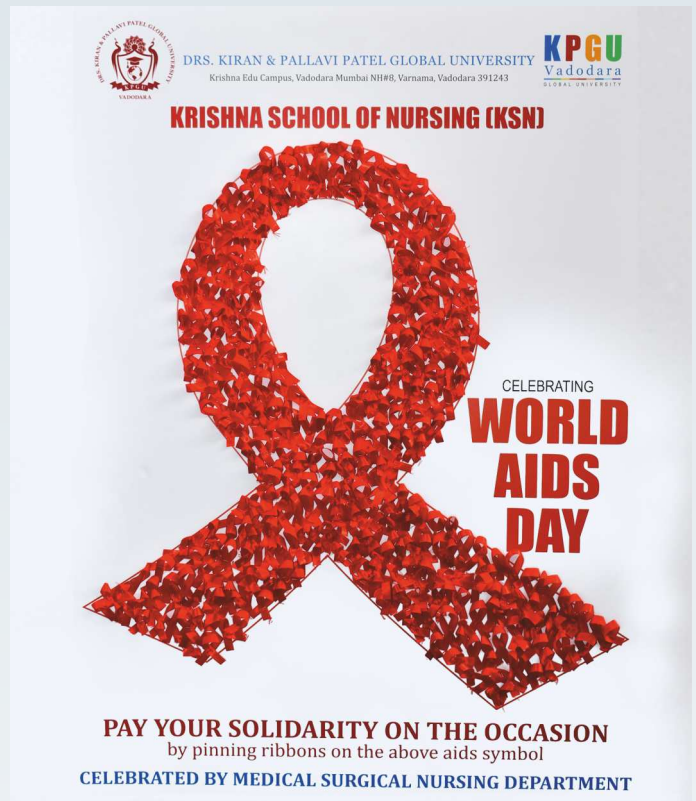

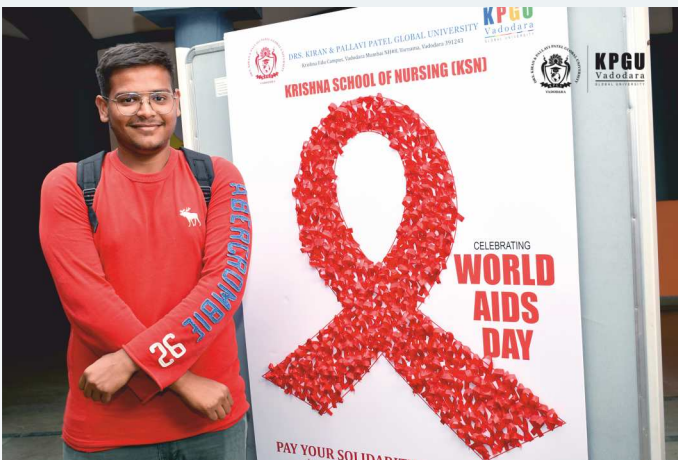
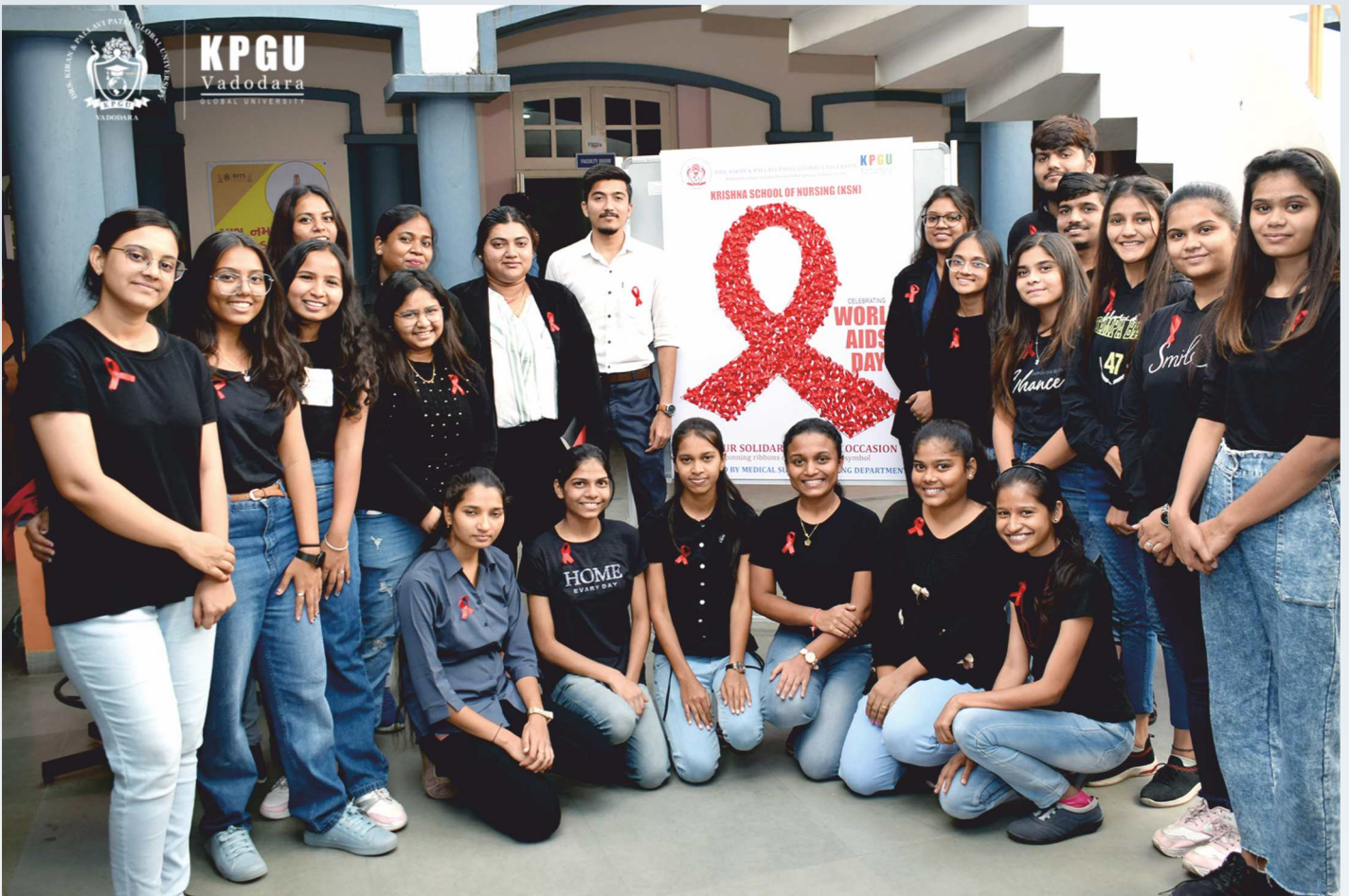




## ● WORLD AIDS DAY CELEBRATION
