Since Research is becoming an integral and perhaps indispensable part of academia. Statistical software and Packages are getting widely used in writing scholarly articles. SPSS is one of the most widely used packages today for research. Having knowledge of this software package can help the researcher a great deal in writing quality research papers.

The FDP was conducted by **Prof.** (**Dr.**) **Kiran Pandya**, **Hon'ble Provost**, **KPGU**. His rich experience in teaching and more specifically in working on SPSS was a big advantage for the participants. Prof. Pandya acclimatized the audience with the basic commands and functionality of SPSS. A t-test report using the demo data file, related to employment details of male and female employees in a sample, was displayed to familiarize and introduce the participants to the use and utility of the software. The fact that statistical tests conducted are to be used as initial indicators to probe deeper and find factors affecting or causing a phenomenon. Certain important limitations of the statistical measure like the mean were also discussed.


